Parking Restrictions in Forge Lane

The recent consultation on the proposed yellow lines in Forge Lane at the corners of Crown Lane, Cob Drive, and Malthouse Lane received overwhelming local support in favour of the restrictions, and Kent County Council has advised that they will now proceed with the necessary Traffic Regulation Order.

Extended 30mph Speed Limit in Pear Tree Lane

After much pressure from the Parish Council, Kent County Council has issued notice of its proposal to extend the 30mph speed limit in Pear Tree Lane from The Willows down to the traffic lights at the junction with the A226 Gravesend Road.
