

Annual Parish Assembly Wednesday 26th April

This is your chance to hear what the Parish Council has been doing over the past year, and to raise any issues. Refreshments will be available, and we hope to see you there.

Council Elections 4th May

Don't forget that the local Borough and Parish Council elections will take place on Thursday 4th May. For the first time, voters will need to produce photo identification at the Polling Stations. This can include your passport, driving licence, official bus pass, blue badge, etc. Full details can be found on the Electoral Commission website at https://www.electoralcommission.org.uk/i-am-a/voter/voter-id/accepted-forms-photo-id, which includes a link to obtain photo ID at https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate if you don't already have it.

This will be the first Borough Council elections under the revised Ward Boundaries. The current 2-member Shorne, Cobham & Luddesdown Ward will cease to exist, and Shorne will become part of a new 3-member Higham & Shorne Ward. Voters in Shorne will be able to vote for up to three candidates.

Coronation Celebrations

We invite you to celebrate the coronation of Charles III with friends and neighbours at the village hall on 6th May. This will include a Celebration Tea, where parishioners will be able to watch the events unfold in the company of others, with refreshments served and entertainment for children.
