## In the Borough of Gravesham

### THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, GRAVESHAM) (SPEED LIMITS) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2022 (AMENDMENT No.1) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the above named Order under sections under Sections 81, 82, 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The effect of the Order will be to reduce the 30mph to 20mph on the following lengths of roads in Shorne, Gravesham:

**BARNDALE COURT, COB DRIVE, CROWN GREEN, COURT LODGE, HOLLAND CLOSE, MANOR FIELD, MILL HILL LANE, THE STREET, WARREN VIEW** - For their entire length. **BUTCHERS HILL** – From its junction with The Street to the western boundary of Hillside Farm. **CROWN LANE** – From its junction with The Street & Forge Lane to its junction with Mill Hill Lane. **FORGE LANE** – From its junction with The Street to a point 160 south of its junction with Gravesham Road. **MALTHOUSE LANE** – From its junction with Forge Lane to its junction with Crown Green. **SWILLERS LANE** – From its junction with The Street & Tanyard Hill to a point 5 metres east of its junction with Barndale Court.

The effect of the Order will be to reduce the current limit to 30mph on the following length of road in Shorne, Gravesham:

**FORGE LANE** – From its junction with Gravesham Road for a distance of 160 meters in a southerly direction.
